For those students who are interested in pursuing a balanced program of study, Elizabeth College provides an Advanced Academic Diploma (ECAAD).

ECAAD ensures a supportive environment for students who wish to achieve at the highest level in their pre-tertiary studies.

Students who show academic ability and a willingness to meet the conditions below are encouraged to apply by expression of interest.

- The program is studied over two years using TCE pretertiary subjects. Year 12 students may be invited to join the program depending on their Year 11 results.
- Students study English and at least one subject from three of the other National Curriculum learning areas of Mathematics, LOTE, Science, Health and Wellbeing, Technology, SOSE and The Arts over their two years.
- Students participate in a Contemporary Issues and Culture program. The program is guided by teachers and students and will provide appreciation of a range of ideas and experiences across the curriculum, including visiting speakers and excursions to the cinema and to theatre and music performances.

- At least one overnight camp is to be attended each year and participants undertake some adventure activities such as rafting, abseiling and rock climbing.
- Candidates must attain an Australian Tertiary Admission Ranking (ATAR) of 90.
- Supports involvement in the University of Tasmania High Achiever Program.
- Successful candidates should actively participate in a College sport, drama, music, service or representative team as offered in the enrichment or sports program.
